Will You Go To Hell After You Die Even Though You Thought You Would Go To Heaven?

Matthew 7:22-23 "Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."

Examine yourself:

Are you truly saved? You may think you are saved, but you are really lost. Let us see what the Holy Bible says on how you can know you are saved.

Have you believed on Jesus Christ? If you have, the Bible says you can know that you have eternal life. The Bible says in 1 John 5:13 "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

Do you know the presence of the Spirit of God? Does the Spirit of God lead you in all truth or do you have to try to figure things out for yourself? 1 John 4:13 "Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit."

Do you love the brethren? If you say you are saved but you do not have Christ-like love towards other Christians, you are lost. Don't deceive yourself. 1 John 2:9-10 "He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now. He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him."



Are you keeping Jesus' commandments? 1 John 2:3-4 "And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him." Apple trees bear apples. Oak trees bear acorns. Christians do good works. Lost people do evil works. If you are saved you will do right.



Are you able to overcome sin or has it overcome you? Christians have the power of God to overcome all sins, even those that are addictive. How? By consistently feeding the spirit and not the flesh. 1 John 2:15 "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him." Christians do not love the world. Your actions show who you

love.

Section 2

From The Old Testament to The New Testament

The Holy Bible says in Hebrews 9:14-15

- 14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
- 15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.



Jesus Christ

The Holy Bible says in Matthew 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

- 6 After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.
- 7 After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles.
- 8 And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

The Holy Bible says in 1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

Summary of

Christ Jesus – The Saviour of Mankind

The Saviour finally came to save souls from the corruption of sin. The Saviour is Jesus. Jesus is God. Jesus Christ came during the Roman world empire. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, left heaven, was born of a virgin, shed his

blood, died, and rose again and then went back to heaven about 2,000 years ago. He fulfilled the law and made it possible for all people to be saved if they would believe on him. All who believe on Jesus Christ will not go to hell fire, but will receive everlasting life. He fulfilled the law and the prophets. Jesus promised he would come again for his own. Jesus started the church.


